There are horizontal and vertical orientations — which are single or double sided — to suit a range of applications. One of the most misunderstood aspects of router placement concerns antenna patterns. Most routers with vertical antennas radiate in a horizontal donut shape, strong signal travels sideways, while the area directly above and below receives weaker coverage.
