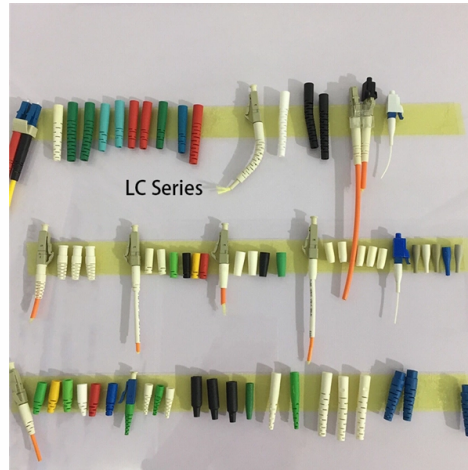


Can optical modules replace network ports
