The height of the bottom of the box should not be less than 1.0m from the ground, and measures should be taken to prevent climbing. All the distribution boxes should be good protected ...

Installation height specifications for distribution boxes

From a functional perspective, it is recommended that distribution boxes for residential use be installed at a height of no less than 1.8 meters to facilitate daily operations.
