

How to connect the network rack power strip

Server racks, from a strict technical. Do not connect your power strip to an ungrounded outlet. Install it away from heat emitting devices such as radiators and heat registers. Do not install where excessive moisture or other conductive contaminants are present. Power Rating of your power strip (see Specifications). Ensure the two Server Rack Mounting Holes in the Reversible Mounting Bracket are flush with the Reversible Mounting Holes and not related in any way to StarTech.
