

Should I reset the fiber optic router before upgrading



Overview

Ideally, you should reboot them at least once a month to clear out the memory and refresh your connections. But don't confuse “reboot” with “reset”—they're different. This allows the modem to re-establish its session, which can clear any connectivity issues stemming from the ISP side. Router Next: After the modem has reconnected, restarting the router allows it to. There's no definitive rule for how often you should reboot your standalone router, gateway, or mesh system. You'll notice this as latency in critical apps, especially if your home is device heavy.
