### Overview

Home distribution boxes typically handle single-phase power supplies and contain 6 to 24 circuits. They include standard circuit breakers for lighting, outlets, and major appliances like water heaters and air conditioning units. They also have the ability to add feed-thru lugs. The Next Gen P1 design introduced in June 2015 has added Extended Circuits up to 66 and has available smaller Enclosures with no Subfeed option and main devices. Siemens also offers a number of specialty panels, like column panels, SEM3 (Embedded Micro Metering). Each element plays a specific role in ensuring safe electrical distribution. The main switch, or main breaker, controls the entire electrical supply to the distribution box. They control how much. 1) Generally, the incoming line of power distribution box adopts five wire system, that is, a, B and C three-way phase line (the general color is yellow, green and red), one way zero line (the color is light blue) and one way ground line (the color is yellow with green stripes).
