

What is the rated capacity A of the circuit breaker in the distribution box



Overview

The number on the main circuit breaker represents the total amperage capacity of your home's entire electrical service. Common residential ratings include 60A, 100A, 150A, and 200A, each signifying a different level of power available for household use. A 60-amp service is considered outdated and. According to NEC Article 240, specifically section 240. 6 (A), the code lists a set of standard ampere ratings beginning at 15 A for fuses and inverse-time circuit breakers. Common NEC standard breaker sizes are 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, and 60A. A 16A continuous load screens to a 20A review point, and 12 AWG copper still stays capped at 20A on a general branch circuit.
